St. Peter's Scholarship Committee

Dear Applicant:

****In order to be eligible to apply for a scholarship, you must meet the following criteria.**

1.) You must be enrolled as a full-time student (12.0 credits minimum/semester) at the college or trade school of your choice in 2025-2026.

AND

2.) You must meet **one** of the following scenarios:

A.) You must have completed the Confirmation program (been **confirmed**) at St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church.

B.) You must have completed a Confirmation program (been **confirmed**) at another Church other than St. Peter's

AND

You must have become a **member** of St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church.

C.) If you are choosing to continue your education as an adult (not immediately after high school), you must be a member of St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church.

**The attached application is available to all who have been accepted at an accredited school of higher education or who are pursuing a course of education beyond high school.

**Each applicant will be evaluated on an individual basis and all information will be kept confidential. Scholarships will be awarded based on the amount of available committee funds.

The completed application **MUST** be returned physically or electronically to the church by April 15, 2025 by 11:59 PM. You may return it personally to the Secretary in the church office from 9:00 am until 2:30 pm Monday-Friday, place it in the Scholarship Committee mailbox in the Friendship Room, or it may be sent via email to st.peterselcscholarship@gmail.com. **No applications will be accepted after April 15, 2025 at 11:59pm.** Every individual who applies for a scholarship will receive a letter regarding their award. The scholarship will be presented in church on Student Recognition Sunday, typically in June.

The monies earned for this fund are made possible due to support from the members and friends of St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church. The purpose of these scholarships is to encourage and support your need for higher education and to assist in financing your goals.
